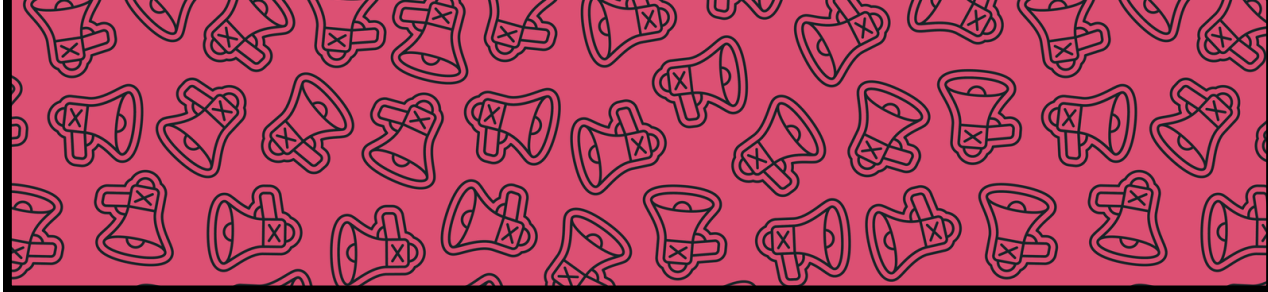

MESSAGING GUIDE




When promoting the SYP elections on social media or within your organisation, please consider the following:

- The SYP elections are key to maintaining the organisation as the democratically elected voice of Scotland's young people. Messaging should support participation, trust, and legitimacy.
- Keep communications clear and accessible. Use plain English and ensure all artwork is simple, relevant, and easy to understand.

Please:

- Maintain political neutrality in all messaging – SYP is non-partisan.
- Avoid promoting specific candidates to ensure fair exposure for all.
- Present MSYPs as real young people with everyday lives, offering a realistic picture of the role.
